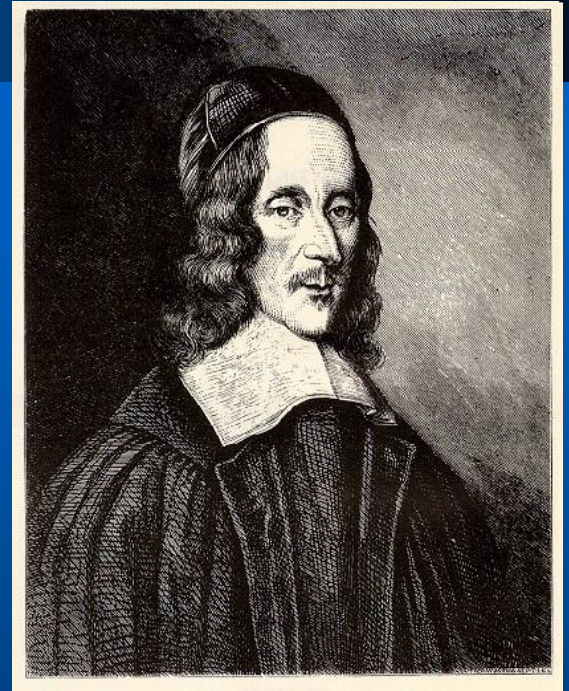

# EFFECTIVE SPIRITUAL PRACTICE

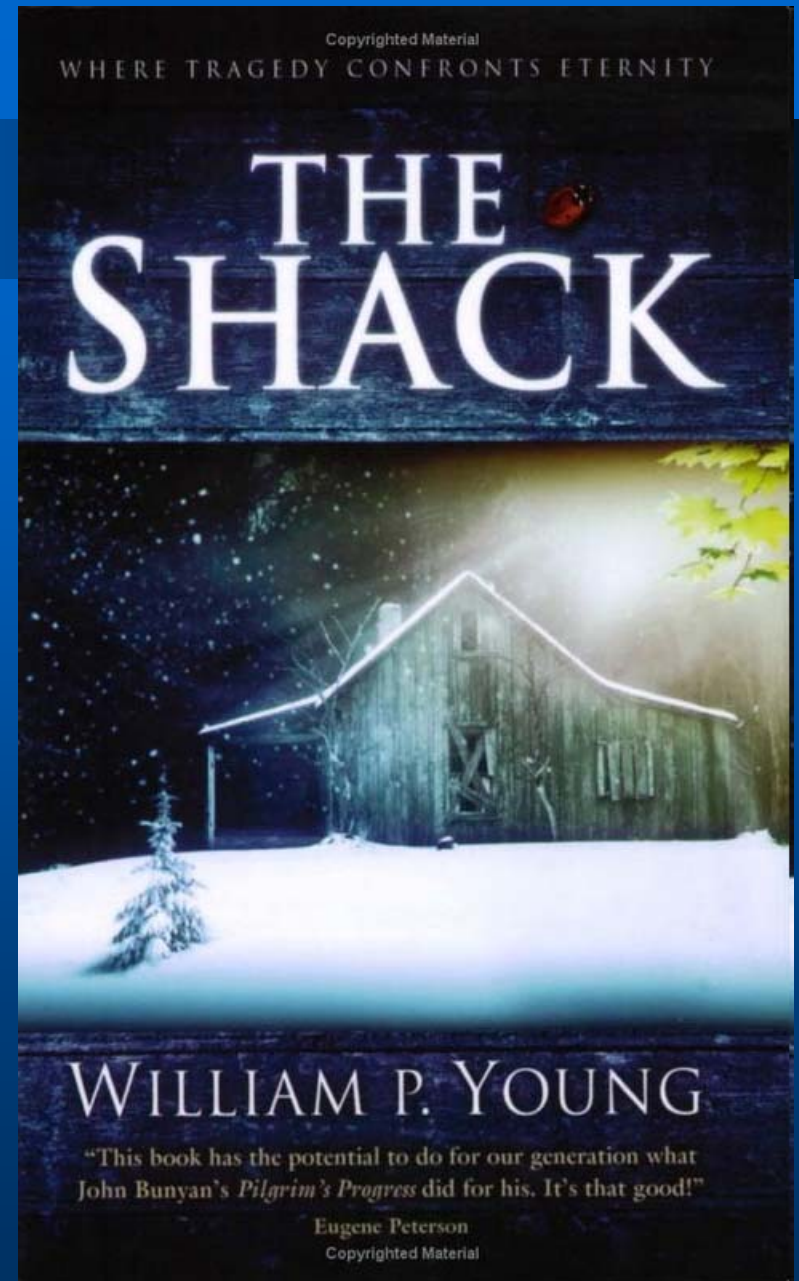
- **Ephesians 1:7** In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of his grace
