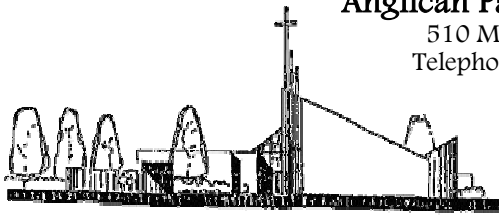

priorities remain clear:

grounds
- to respect the placement of remains and to avoid disturbance
- to move away from roses and to use more local species
- to minimize ongoing maintenance cost and volunteer effort
- to glorify God through the beautification of the space
